Tickets for the High Holidays are currently available and on sale through the Shul's office. The Shul's office hours are Monday thru Friday, 9:00am to 3:00pm.

As a current member in good standing, your membership rate of \$900.00 per year includes two High Holiday tickets.

Supplemental tickets for additional family members are available at the cost of \$100.

Permanent Seats may be purchased, if available, for a flat fee of \$750.00 or \$1,000.00 payable over the course of three years. If the permanent seat you desire was occupied last year by someone else, the person will be given seven days to decide if he or she would like to purchase that as a permanent seat. If they do not elect to do so, you may purchase that seat. Please note that when you buy a permanent seat you are still responsible for the annual membership dues.

Non-members may purchase seats at a rate of \$150 per seat.

Every member will have the opportunity to claim his or her last year's seat.

In order to guarantee last year's seat your membership must be fully paid and all present and past obligations must be satisfied. Any remaining seats that are available will go on general sale.

Note: All past and present financial obligations must be paid completely in order to purchase tickets and renew your membership. We strongly request all our members to pay all obligations as soon as possible in order to retain seats prior to the Holiday. Due to security concerns all congregants MUST have a ticket and no one will be allowed in without their ticket as confirmation of retaining seats prior to the Holiday. The Shul office accepts credit cards as a method of payment for your added convenience.

We ask you to keep in mind that although no policy can be perfect, we are trying as hard as we can to satisfy the needs of our individual congregant's needs. We appreciate the understanding of our congregants and wish you all an upcoming year filled with blessings and harmony.
